Village of Manley Board Regular Meeting Minutes July 6, 2011

A regular meeting of the Board of Trustees was called to order by Chairperson Betty Meyer, at the Manley Fire Barn, at 7:34 p.m.. Chairperson Meyer advised attendees that the Open Meetings Act is posted on the bulletin board for review. Roll Call was taken and members present were Denise Swenson, Kevin Holdorf and Susan Christoffersen.

Review and Approval of Agenda After reviewing the agenda, Kevin Holdorf made a motion to approve agenda as written. Denise Swenson seconded the motion. All agreed.

<u>Public Forum</u> Denise Swenson reported that Shawn McCaully was having sewer problems and that the line may need to be snaked. Betty Meyer said she will look into it.

Kevin Holdorf asked if the monthly Board meetings could be moved to 7pm instead of 7:30pm. After a breif discussion, Kevin Holdorf made a motion to move the regular meeting of the Board of Trustees to 7pm on the first Wednesday of the month. Susan Christoffersen seconded the motion. All agreed.

Review and Approval of Minutes After reviewing the minutes of the June 1 meeting, Denise Swenson made a motion to approve the minutes as written. Kevin Holdorf seconded the motion. All agreed.

<u>Water and Sewer Report</u> Dawn Holdorf presented the water/sewer report stating that three accounts were delinquent and scheduled for disconnection. Denise Swenson made a motion to accept the waer/sewer report. Susan Christoffersen seconded the motion. All agreed.

<u>Vacant Board Position</u> Betty Meyer said she has spoken to a resident that may be interested and urged them to attend the next meeting. Kevin Holdorf said he also has spoken to a resident about joining the Board.

SENDD Dues Notice The annual dues notice for SENDD was reviewed and noted no increase from the prior year. Denise Swenson made a motion to pay the \$ 275.00 to cover the fiscal period of 7/1/11 to 6/30/12. Betty Meyer seconded the motion. All agreed.

<u>Tree City USA</u> Kevin Holdorf said he was interested in exploring options available in becoming a Tree City. An inventory of existing trees within the community would need to be made along with other criteria to be designated a Tree City. The benefits would include grants available to the community to hire or even train an arborist.

Spur Repair Denise Swenson stated concerns over the open curb area where the new road meets the spur road. It is a potential danger for motorcyclists but also could damage any vehicle that may cut the corner too tight. There was discussion as to whether the Village is responsible or the State. Betty Meyer said she will check with JEO and see if they would know.

<u>Ordinance Complaint Review</u> Susan Christoffersen stated that she has had the van removed from her property within the sixty days she requested. Betty Meyer stated she has formed a list of four residents also in violation of Ordinance 90.5 and she has drafted a letter to send out to them.

<u>Treasurer's Report</u> Denise Swenson advised the Board that she has opened an account for the Manley Community Center. Donations will now be placed in the account to help with the purchase and further

renovations of the building.
