EMERGENCY VILLAGE BOARD MEETING
February 25, 2024

The Emergency Meeting of the Village Board of Trustees was called to order by Chairman Denise Swenson at 7:32 pm on Sunday, February 25, 2024. Discussion of Doug and Tanya Schmidt settlement offer for Special Use Permit:

Chairman Denise Swenson stated that the Village attorney had called and said Tanya Schmidt made a settlement offer to the Village Board. He said that Schmidt offered to pay the Board \$1000 for the Board to accept and pass the Special Use Permit.

Taylor Johnson researched and presented numbers what the Village has paid the attorney in the year 2023 for his services. The amount was \$11,400.34 with approximately 90% of the total amount for the Schmidt case for the Special Use Permit.

The Board had a discussion and voted on whether or not to accept the offer..

Vote being yes to accept the offer and no to not accept.
